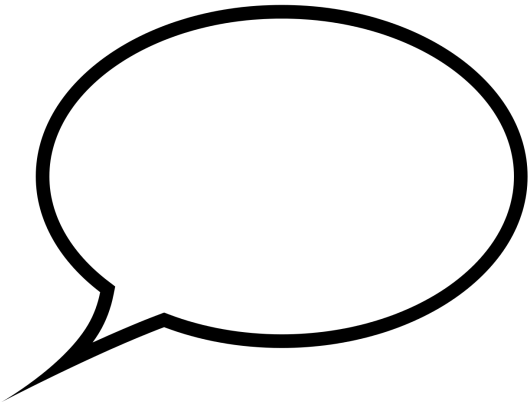


Social Problem Solving Scenarios for Kindergarten & Early Elementary
